Clients succeed because of SafeHaven supporters

Jennifer, a 22-year-old client with two young children, came to the Fort Worth shelter to escape her extremely violent and controlling abuser. He controlled every aspect of her life, including when she saw her family, what she wore and her finances. When she left him, he destroyed her furniture and parts of her home. Jennifer loves her job as a medical assistant, but had to be transferred because of her abuser's constant harassment at work. He even busted out her car window while her coworkers watched, horrified. During this time she had to transport her special needs child seventy miles each way every day so he could stay with family members during the day -- this was the only childcare option she had. Fed up, Jennifer filed for and was granted a protective order and is working with SafeHaven's legal team to get a divorce. She closely follows her safety plan, attends counseling sessions lined up by her caseworker and was accepted into SafeHaven's transitional



living program, where she will live rent free with her children for two years while continuing case management and counseling. She is dedicated to creating a safe life for herself and her children.

Your help as a SafeHaven supporter enables us to provide these services to clients like Jennifer, who otherwise would have no hope. Without

emergency shelter, counseling, legal assistance and transitional living, Jennifer would be living in fear each day. Without your help, Jane might not be living at all.

Below are some of the numbers that quantify the services we were able to provide to domestic violence survivors in 2009 with the help of our generous supporters. On behalf of those survivors, we would like to say thank you to each and every one of you!

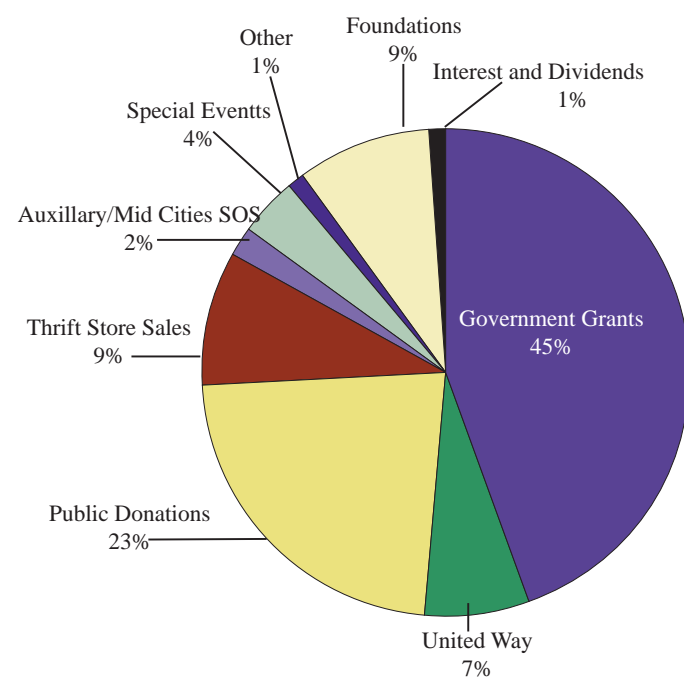
- SafeHaven answered 50,120 hotline calls in 2009, up 9,000 from 2008.

- We sheltered a total of 2,571 victims of domestic violence in 2009. 1,441 of those were children.

- 74 adults and 130 children lived in SafeHaven's transitional living program.

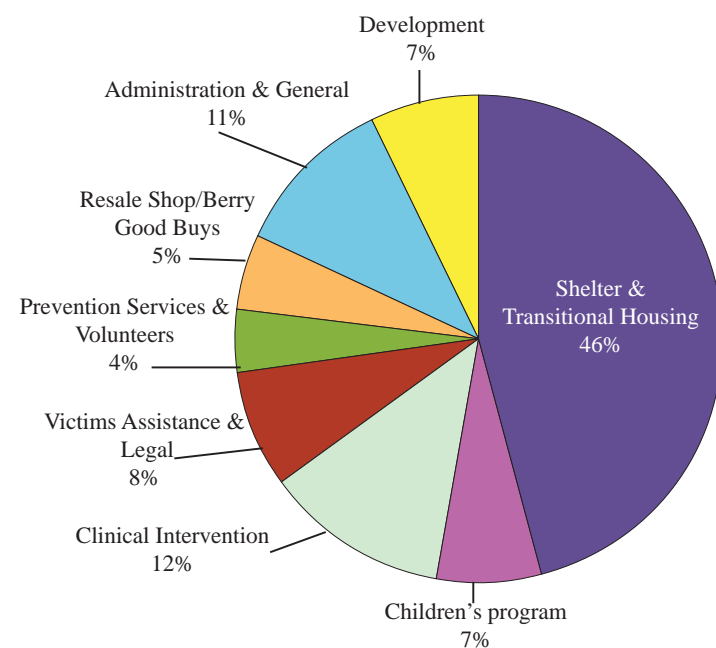
- 3,860 women and children sought counseling at one of our resource centers.

Prevention Services provides education, training

In 2009, what used to be the Education Services department made an important transition. Now Prevention Services, our team of domestic violence prevention educators takes its message of healthy relationships to as many school districts and community organizations as possible.

Through partnerships with Fort Worth, Arlington, Mansfield, Birdville, Azle, White Settlement, Keller, Hurst-Euless-Bedford, Kennedale, Burleson, Crowley, Grapevine-Colleyville, Everman, Carroll and Eagle Mountain/Saginaw Independent School Districts, SafeHaven facilitated SafeDate teen dating violence awareness campaigns that touched more than

SafeHaven provided educational programs to 21,683 youths and adults county wide.

21,683 students and faculty.

SafeHaven also wrapped up its SafeCommunities project in White Settlement and Haltom City but made lasting connections within both communities. SafeCommunities is a primary prevention program that promotes

safety in families, schools, businesses and other organizations. The project's goal is to reduce family violence by helping these communities identify and address the causes of violence in their neighborhoods. The key to this initiative is that SafeHaven does not dictate to community members what they must do to reduce family violence. Rather, SafeHaven helps create the space and language for the community to define the problems as they see them and assist them in addressing those issues by utilizing the area's existing strengths.

In late 2009, SafeHaven instituted the initiative in Mansfield and the 76110 zip code in Fort Worth.

Memories of helping fuel Volunteer of the Year

Two years ago, Barbara Joan Dalke was manning her on-call client services post at the Arlington shelter when a young woman entered the shelter. She was taken into the woods and raped by her abuser and came from the hospital. She had nothing in her possession but the hospital gown she arrived in and her hair was matted with weeds and grass.

"She just clung to me," Barbara said. "She had no place to go, no clothes and nothing of her own. This moment stands out in my mind because I felt like I was really doing something for somebody."

Barbara made sure the young woman had a new outfit from the shelter store and was settled in her room before she left her shift that day.

"I stayed with her until I thought that she was feeling as good as she could feel that day," she said.

This kind of dedication is why Barbara is the 2009 recipient of SafeHaven's Volunteer of the Year Award. She has been working in the client services center for five years, where she answers phones, takes care of any client needs that arise, puts out snacks, makes sure clients have clothing and escorts clients from the police station to the shelter. She started volunteering after she retired from AT&T in St. Louis and moved to Mansfield with her husband, Don.

Don is also a SafeHaven supporter – they worked together at the Fort Worth Santa's Sack location during the 2009 holiday season.

"I didn't do well with retirement because I wasn't doing enough," she said. "A friend introduced me to SafeHaven and I really enjoy it. I have a real good feeling when I'm there and I feel like I'm doing something worthwhile."

2009 Shelter and SafeLiving update

SafeHaven's two emergency shelters housed 2,579 women and children in 2009. Our counseling

centers saw 3,860, an increase of more than 500 from the year before. CEO Mary Lee Hafley told one Star-Telegram reporter that this increase may have something to do with lingering effects of the nation's economic crisis.

"More victims are staying in their homes and seeking services in an outreach setting," she said. "Because of the economy, they may be even more hesitant to leave any vestige of financial security so they seek counseling, support groups, legal & case management services on an outreach basis while they try to make the best plan for themselves and their children."

1,138 adults were protected at our emergency shelters

1,441 children found safety at our emergency shelters

50,121 calls were answered on the SafeHaven Hotline

71 families participated in our transitional living program in 2009

3,860 women and children sought counseling at one of our resource centers.

Hotline calls jumped to 50,121, up from just over 40,000 in 2008 and 71 families participated in SafeLiving, our transitional living program.

Also in 2009, with the help of Recovery Act funding, SafeHaven was able to add a stabilization six-month housing program to expand SafeLiving's two-year program.

Inaugural Mens' event highlight of 2009

SafeHaven saw great strides in reaching out to the community via events, marketing, fundraising and the media during 2009.

The newest success of the year was the first annual Legacy of Men Breakfast. The keynote speaker was Don McPherson, former professional football player and expert on men's violence against women. The 270 guests heard his dynamic, challenging words, stood shoulder to shoulder with legends like Daryl Johnston and Joe Theismann and helped

SafeHaven launch a new initiative to engage and mobilize men to end domestic violence. Jason Witten received the agency's first ever Legacy of Men Award for his support of domestic violence victims via the SCORE Foundation, which funds male mentoring positions in shelter children's programs. The event raised \$20,000 and built great momentum towards 2010's event.

The Legacy of Women Awards Luncheon, held at the Dallas Cowboy's Stadium, brought in more than \$90,000. SafeHaven honored fifteen amazing women: Margo Dean, Christine Cook, Nina Jackson, Ramona Osburn, Louise Appleman, Deborah Ferguson, Carmen Garcia, Harriet Harral, Diane Stow, Linda Curry, Susan Stevens Crummel, Dr. Joyce Mauk, Marti VanRavenswaay, Karen Parsinen, and Janie Rector.

A record 120 stores participated in SafeHaven's HeartCard shopping event. Held in October, HeartCard raised more than \$20,000 and achieved its primary goal of getting SafeHaven's name into the community where people may not have had access to our information.



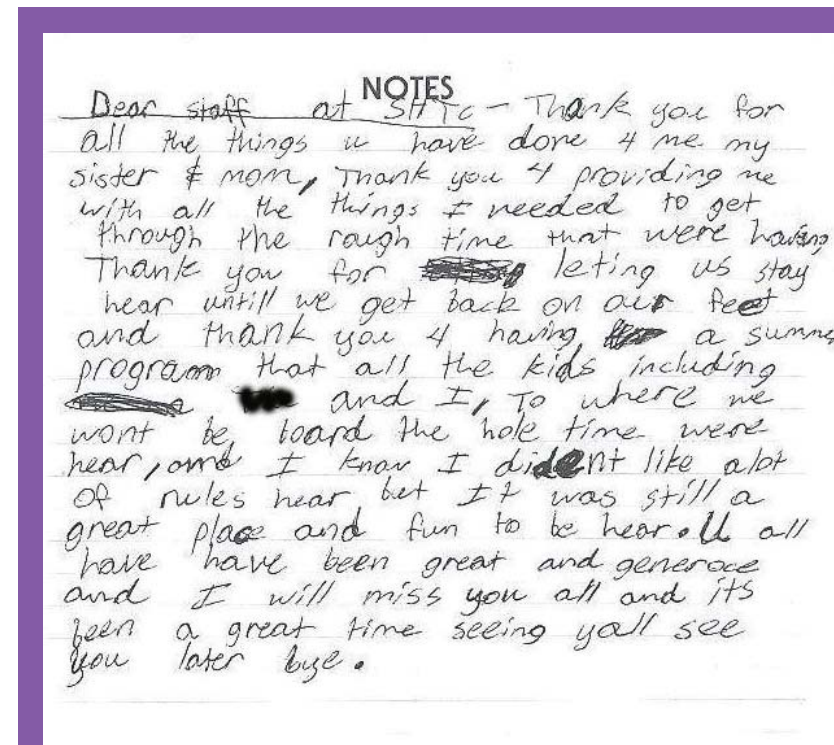
Former professional football player and expert on mens violence against women Don McPherson was the keynote speaker for the 2009 Legacy of Men Breakfast.

Also in 2009, SafeHaven celebrated 30 years in the community with a campaign to raise \$30,000 in 30 Days. The fundraising campaign was successful and all who supported it came to a reception held at Len and Laurie Roberts' home. The party also marked the beginning of SafeHaven's new SafeFutures Donor Society, which is made up of those who donate \$1,000 or more per year.

SafeHaven also feted the end of a long renovation process at the Fort Worth shelter. With fresh paint everywhere, repairs made and a brand-new commercial-grade kitchen, Chefs Brian Olenjack of Olenjack's Grille and Blaine Staniford of GRACE came and showcased their skills for board members and donors who contributed to the project. Both chefs cooked a signature dish to show how great the new kitchen works.

Other development and marketing accomplishments for 2009 include:

- Garnered nearly 90 news clips and public service announcements through public rela-

CEO Notes



We could easily say, “2009 was a very bad year”. The economy continued to weaken resulting in financial challenges for SafeHaven as well as our clients. In order to keep all programs operational, we scrutinized expenses and our programs. Eventually, we streamlined services, eliminating nine positions and cutting 4 more back to part-time; re-negotiated vendor contracts; located new suppliers at lower costs; and, saved over \$250,000 annually. Simultaneously, we increased gifts from individuals by 25% over 2008.

This didn’t completely offset declines in other funding sources, but it clearly communicated your commitment to domestic violence victims and your confidence in SafeHaven’s work. For that, we are grateful.

When the economy falters, those with fewer resources suffer first and for a longer period of time. So, our clients faced more challenges in achieving independence and our staff became even more resourceful. Recovery Act funds strengthened means for families teetering on the edge of returning to an abusive situation due to lack of any financial stability. However, both victims and those who help them had to call on new levels of courage and fortitude to keep moving forward.

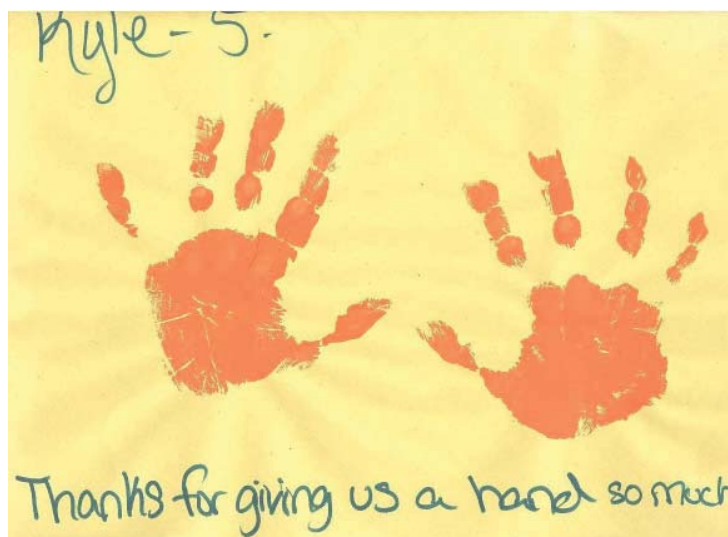
Rosie entered SafeLiving, our transitional living program, in April 2009. On disability due to her injuries, she was saddled with significant debt created by her abuser who was now nowhere to be found. With budgeting skills taught by her caseworker, Rosie saved \$200 her first month in the program. While it might seem advantageous for the batterer to literally disappear, it means Rosie couldn’t collect child support for her young son or obtain sole custody. SafeHaven’s

legal team began representing her in custody issues while she worked at a local school district and continued saving money and reducing her debt. By the end of 2009, her debt was under control, she is repairing her credit, and staff connected her to Tarrant County Housing Partnership with the real possibility of purchasing her own home.

Such commitment to change by Rosie and hundreds of other clients and the SafeHaven staff who guide them everyday inspires me. 2009 was not such a bad year for Rosie. In fact, it wasn’t so bad for SafeHaven. Regardless of the economic challenges we face, SafeHaven protects, saves and changes lives everyday. You do, too, as part of our family of supporters who understand violence against women and children must end.
